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The District Board of Trustees of South Florida State College recognizes that the receipt of grants from governmental entities, private businesses, corporations, or foundations often marks the difference between a good institution and an excellent one. As a consequence, the Board authorizes the College president to establish a system of regulations related to the management of grant funds after the grant has received formal approval by the Board.

Anyone employed by or associated with South Florida State College who solicits grant funds (whether individually or through another entity) from any source on behalf of the College or any of its divisions, programs, or functions must have prior approval from the executive director, institutional effectiveness, planning, and technology and/or the president.
