The District Board of Trustees authorizes the College to accept transfer credit from other colleges and universities.

The District Board of Trustees authorizes the College to evaluate and award accelerated/experiential learning credit so that students may earn credits toward a degree or certificate. Such credit may be based on noncredit coursework and prior experience, such as jobs held, workshops, volunteer work, or a number of other types of experiences or nationally recognized examinations.

The president is authorized to establish procedures related to the transfer of credits and award accelerated/experiential learning credit.
